

SEASON PASSES, TICKETS AND APEX CARDS ARE PERSONAL, NON ASSIGNABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE AND NON-REFUNDABLE.

The member-skier/snowboarder recognizes that skiing, snowboarding and other Snow Sports and the use of ski lifts involve inherent dangers and he/she accepts full responsibility for all **PHYSICAL OR MATERIAL DAMAGES**, resulting from said risks and inherent dangers. Therefore, he/she accepts to redeem and exonerate **Ski Bromont** from all responsibility which may arise. For all legal purposes, the subscriber takes up residence in the province of Quebec, forum for any claims, and that Quebec's laws apply.

The member-skier/snowboarder should immediately advise the station in the event of **FORGET, LOSS OR THEFT OF HIS/HER SEASON OR APEX PASS**. A new season pass will then be issued to the skier/snowboarder for the moderate sum of \$10 taxes included, excluding the \$ 5 deposit.

A \$ 5 deposit (GST and QST not applicable) will be required in order to issue the card and will be remitted when the card is returned in a good condition.

The member-skier/snowboarder also assumes entire responsibility for all types of damages resulting from not respecting **SAFETY RULES AND REGULATIONS** and in effect frees and exonerates **Ski Bromont** of all damages related to such shortcomings. On this matter, the member realizes that it is **mandatory** to wear a helmet in snow parks.

The member-skier/snowboarder recognizes that the pass is for his own personal use and that all other usage will bring serious consequences, such as definite cancellation of the pass or he may be liable to pursuits to the criminal who can entail a fine or a prison sentence of a maximal period of two (2) years ("fraud", article 380 of the Criminal Code). Photos are taken at the chairlift's gates to control holders's identity.

The only **SKI OR SNOWBOARDING LESSONS AUTHORIZED ON THE MOUNTAIN** are the ones sold and registered by the **Ski Bromont** Ski School. All individuals interested in offering ski/snowboarding lessons on the Mountain must have received prior authorization from the proper authority linked to the resort. All individuals caught in the act of trying to teach clients and/or employees could be refused purchase of a ski lift-ticket/season pass or the seizure of either/or ski lift-ticket/season pass in effect.

THE MEMBER-SKIER/SNOWBOARDER AT FAULT on the site of **Ski Bromont** premises will see his season pass cancelled or seized without prior notice or reimbursement (i.e.: a member-skier/snowboarder surprised in the act of committing a felony). **Ski Bromont** reserves judgement upon whether to suspend a season pass and/or impose a fine. All season passes sold in virtue of those present, will remain **Ski Bromont's** property and binds the skier/snowboarder to return said pass upon the station's simple request.

The member-skier/snowboarder must have a proper understanding of the **SKIABLE TIMES PERMITTED BY HIS/HER SEASON PASS**. People found skiing at times that are not included in their enrolment may have their season pass suspended and may even be fined.

SEASON PASS

Anytime: Everyday, from opening to closing

7 Days: Everyday, from opening until 5 pm

Zenith: Monday to Friday, from opening to closing + weekends as of 1 pm

Exclusions: Valid as of 1 pm during Christmas Holidays

Bonus: 7 days and 7 nights:

- From the opening of the season until December 25
- On January 1
- During South shore Spring Break
- As of March 15, 2021

Almost anytime: Monday to Friday, from opening to closing + weekends as of 3 pm

Exclusions: Valid as of 3 pm during Christmas Holidays and South shore Spring Break.

Bonus: 7 days and 7 nights:

- From the opening of the season until December 25
- On January 1
- As of March 15, 2021

Nights: 7 nights, from 5 pm to closing and this, until the end of night skiing.

Night skiing non available on December 24.

Bonus: Valid during the day after the night skiing closed

Weekdays Max: Monday to Friday, from opening to closing

Exclusions: Valid from 5 pm to closing during Christmas Holidays and South shore Spring Break.

M2J: Tuesday to Thursday, from opening until 5 pm

Exclusions: Christmas Holidays and South shore Spring Break.

Mont Soleil: Valid from opening to closing only on the Mont Soleil slope side, at chairlifts #1 and #2

DAILY TICKETS

Apex Card: 2 to 8 tickets valid at all times, without any restrictions for the 2020-2021 season
Non-transferable individual card
Credit applicable for a season pass purchase*

In the case of the purchase of a **Family season pass** or in the case of the **4+ group rates purchase**, the payer of the present commits to inform all members of his/her family or all members of the group, of the terms and regulations of the said subscription, and of all the obligations burden for the season pass holder. It's not possible to change the members of the family or the group after the purchase.

Ski Bromont reserves the right to modify its schedule and to close certain or all the chairlifts without notice.

MOUNTAIN CODE OF CONDUCT

Code adopted under the Act respecting safety in sports.
This Code applies to all persons practicing Snow Sports.

1. Remain in control of your speed and direction. Make sure you can stop and avoid any person or obstacle.
2. Yield the right of way to persons downhill and choose a course that assures their safety.
3. Stop on a trail only if you are visible from above and if you are not obstructing the trail.
4. Yield the right of way to persons uphill when entering a trail and at intersections.
5. If you are involved in or witness an accident, remain at the scene and identify yourself to a Ski-Patroller.
6. Use and wear at all times a proper device to prevent runaway equipment.
7. Do not use lifts and runways if you are under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
8. Obey all signs and warnings and never venture off the trails or onto a closed trail.

The practice of Snow Sports has an inherent risk and danger that you should be aware of. For a safe and enriching experience, you should respect the Mountain Code of Conduct at all times and always show courtesy to others.

You must obey all other rules, signs or marking which are placed and physically defined by the station.

INHERENT RISK AND DANGERS

The following elements constitute, among others and non-restrictive, some of the inherent risk and dangers the *skier / snowboarder* must be aware of:

1. Changing climatic conditions;
2. Variation in the degree of incline of the slopes;
3. Mountain's natural conditions, such as the presence of: ditches, crevasses and streams, rocks, bare spots, bushes, shrubs, lumps of earth, trees, tree growths, stumps as well as any natural obstacle;
4. The presence of ice and ice patches; above and/or below the snow surface; any condition changes on the skiable surface.
5. Any/all collision with another skier / snowboarder or any person;
6. The presence of pylons, poles and other structures used in exploiting the station as well as collision with these elements;
7. The use of mechanical lifts;
8. The presence of mobile maintenance equipment, emergency vehicles as well as snowmaking equipment.

While practising Snow Sports, the skier / snowboarder assumes the sole and entire responsibility of all physical or material damages associated with an inherent risk and the skier / snowboarder exonerates the ski resort of any responsibility derived from it.

The contract in virtue of which the present lift ticket was issued is subject to the laws in force in Quebec. The holder of the present lift ticket, as well as the issuer of said ticket, agree to elect domicile in the judicial district of Bedford, province of Quebec and declare that same is the appropriate forum for any and all claims, of whatever nature, arising from the contract in virtue of which the present ticket was issued.
